effect after my decease, do make, declare
and publish this as, and to be my last
Will and Testament, in form following, to wit-

1st Item. I command my spirit to
God, and request of my Executors, the decent
burial of my body.

2nd Item. I direct the payment
of all my just debts and the expenses
of administration.

3rd Item. All my land and other
property of every kind, not herein before
disposed of, including debts due, I give
devise and bequeath to my wife, Mary
and my children, Elizabeth M. Mapenburg
wife of William C. Mapenburg, Lucy C. Biggs
wife of Rader Biggs, Virginia Morecock, wife of
John D. Morecock, Helen Daughtry, wife of William
H. Daughtry, James L. Myricks and Walter,

B. Myrick, to be equally divided between
them, and one seventh part thereof to
each of them, and their respective heirs
and assigns for his and their only proper
use and behoof forever.

4th Item and last - I hereby revoke all
other wills, and for the due execution
of the trusts of this do nominate and
appoint my sons in law, William C.
Chapenbury, Hader Biggs, John E. Morcock
and William H. Daughtry, Executors...
